Cleveland, OH – (July 19, 2010) – **Young Audiences ArtWorks** will host two **Summer Arts Performances** on July 28 and August 4, 2010. **Both performances are family-friendly, FREE and open to the public.**

The July 28<sup>th</sup> performance will take place at **Cleveland Institute of Music, 11021 East Boulevard, Cleveland, at 6:00 pm in Kulas Hall.** The performance will include presentations and exhibits by 60 ArtWorks apprentices including painting, stage combat, ceramics, theater and vocal music.

The August 4<sup>th</sup> performance will take place at **Cuyahoga Community College Metro-Campus, 2900 Community College Avenue, Cleveland, in the Studio Theater and Lobby of the Center for Creative Arts, at 6:00pm.** The performance will include presentations and exhibits by 60 ArtWorks apprentices, including a percussion ensemble, dance, fashion, drawing, recording arts and culinary arts.

Original artwork will be sold at both events to raise money for next year's ArtWorks program.
